### WHO ARE THE NAVIGATORS?

Navigators are education advisors for families. They include award-winning teachers, veteran principals, and experienced guidance counselors with deep knowledge of local school systems.

### HOW CAN MY NAVIGATOR HELP ME AND MY FAMILY?

Whether you're looking for more support for a child in school, searching for ways to make homework less stressful, or trying to keep a teenager on the path to college, your Navigator can provide expert guidance and hands-on support. Their job is to help you and your family achieve your educational goals.

### WHICH TYPES OF STUDENTS CAN EDNAVIGATOR SUPPORT?

EdNavigator supports families with students of all ages but specializes in school-aged students in elementary, middle and high school. EdNavigator assists families and students in public, private and charter schools, including students who are struggling as well as those who are excelling.

### HOW DO I ACCESS MY NAVIGATOR?

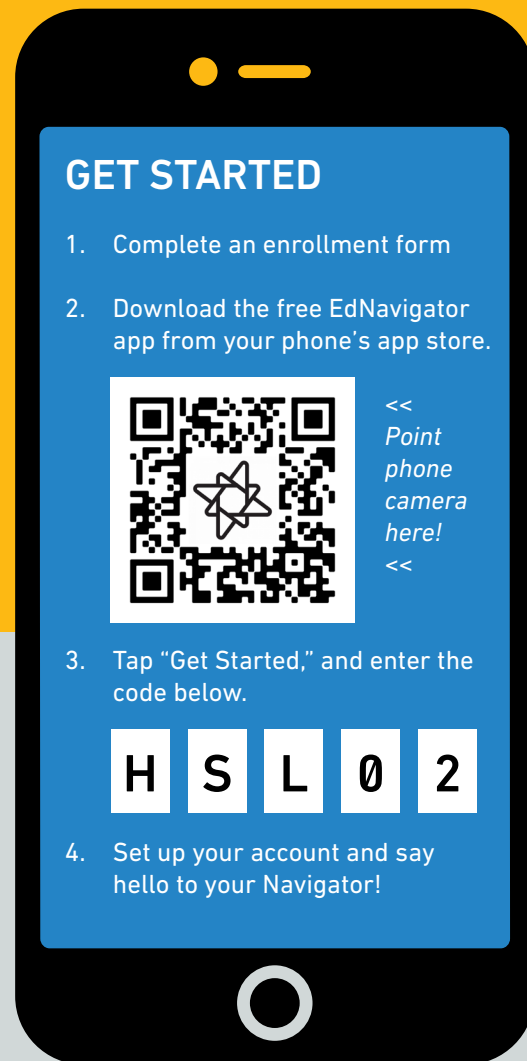
You can call or chat with your Navigator via the EdNavigator app, or meet confidentially in-person at HSL (when it's safe).

### WHAT HAPPENS AFTER I SIGN UP?

After you download our app and create your account, you'll be connected to a Navigator who can start answering your questions right away. Your Navigator will get to know you and your family and provide ongoing, expert help achieving your education goals.

### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

HSL asks participating employees to contribute to the cost of the service through their existing tuition reimbursement benefit and an automatically deducted co-pay. The exact co-pay amount varies based on your salary level; employees earning less than \$40,000 pay about \$1 per pay period. See the EdNavigator enrollment form for more information.
